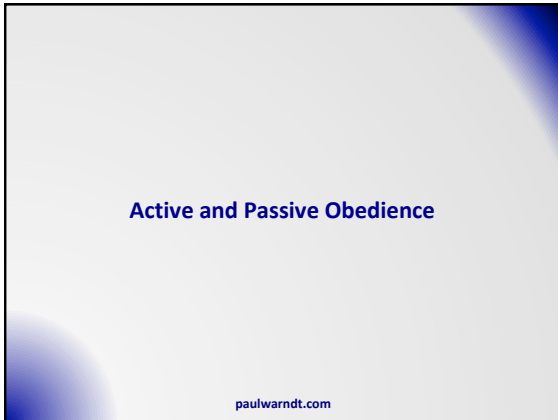
Luke 2:22-ff: When the *time of their purification according to the Law of Moses had been completed*, Joseph and Mary took him to Jerusalem ... (NIV)

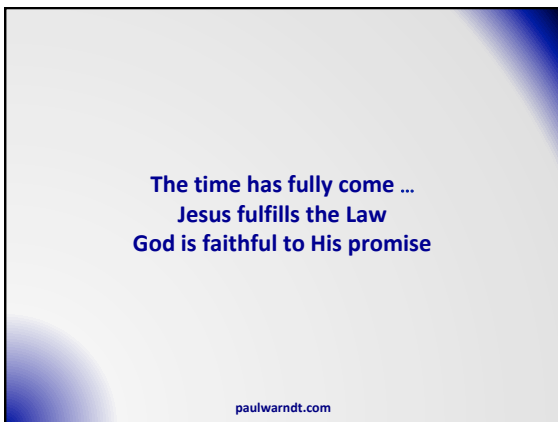
