John 20:13-15: They (the angels) asked her (Mary), "Woman, why are you crying?"


14"They have taken my Lord away," she said, "and I don't know where they have put him."


7'The Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, be crucified and on the third day be raised again.' "

11But they did not believe the women, because their words <u>seemed to them like nonsense</u>. (NIV)




