
not ... plan "a" "b" "c" finally ... Jesus Christ comes

fulfill them = "fill them to the full"

John 3:14-15 <u>Just as Moses lifted up the snake in</u> the wilderness, <u>so</u> the Son of Man must be lifted up, 15 that everyone who believes may have eternal life in him. (NIV)

The Genesis Account (Myth, Metaphor or True Story?)

"origin, beginning"

... of the world
... of humanity
... of sin and death
... of the promise of Jesus

Just as ... in the first Adam So also ... in the Second Adam (Jesus)

Because of one man's act ...

Romans 5:12-ff: Therefore, just as sin entered the world through one man, and death through sin, and in this way death came to all men, because all sinned—13 for before the law was given, sin was in the world. But sin is not taken into account when there is no law. (NIV)

Romans 5:12-ff: 14Nevertheless, death reigned from the time of Adam to the time of Moses, even over those who did not sin by breaking a command, as did Adam, who was a pattern of the one to come.

Romans 5:15: But the gift is not like the trespass. For if the many died by the trespass of the one man, how much more did God's grace and the gift that came by the grace of the one man, Jesus Christ, overflow to the many! (NIV)

Romans 5:18: Consequently, just as the result of one trespass was condemnation for all men, so also the result of one act of righteousness was justification that brings life for all men. (NIV)

Romans 5:19 For just as through the disobedience of the one man the many were made sinners, so also through the obedience of the one man the many will be made righteous. (NIV)

In Adam ... we sin ... so also, Jesus becomes the sin

in Adam ... we die ... so also, Jesus dies and pays death's wage

we're connected to Adam so also, through faith, we're connected to the 2nd Adam



Genesis 3:15: And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and hers; he will crush your head, and you will strike his heel."



"the generations ..."

Genesis 5:1

This is the <u>book of the generations of Adam</u>. In the day that God created man, he made him in God's likeness. (NIV)

Gen. 6:9 This is the history of the generations of Noah:

Gen. 10:1

Now this is the history of the sons of Noah and of Shem, Ham, and Japheth. (NIV)

Gen. 11:10

This is the history of the generations of Shem:

Genesis 11:27

Now this is the history of the generations of <u>Terah</u>. Terah became *the* <u>father of Abram</u>, Nahor, and Haran. (NIV)

Matthew 1:1-ff: A <u>record of the genealogy of</u>
Jesus Christ the son of David, the son of
Abraham: (NIV)

"covenants"

"covenant" contract, agreement, testament my word is my bond

purpose = bind two parties together in unbroken relationship

Types of Covenants

ONE WAY – superior makes a binding covenant to another (lesser party)

"I am going to do this for you ..."

"I will keep my word ..."

"I will be faithful ...

ONE WAY

Noah and all of Humanity (never again ...)

Abraham (the Promised Seed)

David (the Messiah, the King, the Son of David)

with Noah (Genesis 6:18-21)
with the world (rainbow) (Genesis 9:13-17)

1 Peter 3:18-22: For Christ died for sins once for all, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God. (NIV)

1 Peter 3:18-22: He was put to death in the body but made alive by the Spirit, 19 through whom also he went and preached to the spirits in prison 20 who disobeyed long ago when God waited patiently in the days of Noah while the ark was being built. (NIV)

1 Peter 3:18-22: In it only a few people, eight in all, were saved through water, 21 and this water symbolizes baptism that now saves you also—(NIV)

1 Peter 3:18-22: --not the removal of dirt from the body but the pledge of a good conscience toward God. It saves you by the resurrection of Jesus Christ, (NIV)

with Abraham, Isaac and Jacob Genesis 12 and 15

Galatians 3:6-7: Consider Abraham: "He believed God, and it was credited to him as righteousness."

Understand, then, that those who believe are children of Abraham. (NIV)

Galatians 3:8-9: The Scripture foresaw that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, and announced the gospel in advance to Abraham: "All nations will be blessed through you."

So those who have faith are blessed along with Abraham, the man of faith. (NIV)

Galatians 3:16: The promises were spoken to Abraham and to his seed. The Scripture does not say "and to seeds," meaning many people, but "and to your seed," meaning one person, who is Christ. (NIV)

David – the KING (2 Samuel 7)

Types of Covenants

TWO WAY – superior makes a binding covenant to another (lesser party) AND the other party pledges a <u>response</u>.

with Israelites at Sinai (Mosaic) Exodus 20 and 24:7,8

Exodus 20:2"I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery.

Therefore ...
In Response to this ...

3"You shall have no other gods before me. (NIV)

The Triune God ... makes and keeps promises the "unholy Trinity" lies

God's people break the covenant unfaithful, disobedient, rebellious

Message of the Prophets

Why are these things happening to us?

"You have broken the covenant!"

"Repent!"

Good News ... One day there will be One who will be the fulfillment of all of the Covenants ...

the Seed of Abraham
the Son of David
the Perfect One who Keeps All of the Law

Hebrews 7-10

Jesus Christ, the Mediator of the eternal covenant

Hebrews 13:20-21: May the God of peace, who through the blood of the eternal covenant brought back from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great Shepherd of the sheep, equip you with everything good for doing his will ... (NIV)

Hebrews 13:20-21: ... and may he work in us what is pleasing to him, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen.

(NIV)


Messiah Comes from a Twisted Family Tree

Matthew 1:1-ff: A record of the genealogy of Jesus Christ the son of David, the son of Abraham:

2 Abraham was the father of Isaac, Isaac the father of Jacob, Jacob the father of Judah and his brothers, 3 Judah the father of Perez and Zerah, whose mother was Tamar (NIV)

Matthew 1:5-ff: 5 Salmon the father of Boaz, whose mother was Rahab (NIV)

Matthew 1:5-ff: Boaz the father of Obed, whose mother was Ruth, Obed the father of Jesse, and Jesse the father of King David. (NIV)
