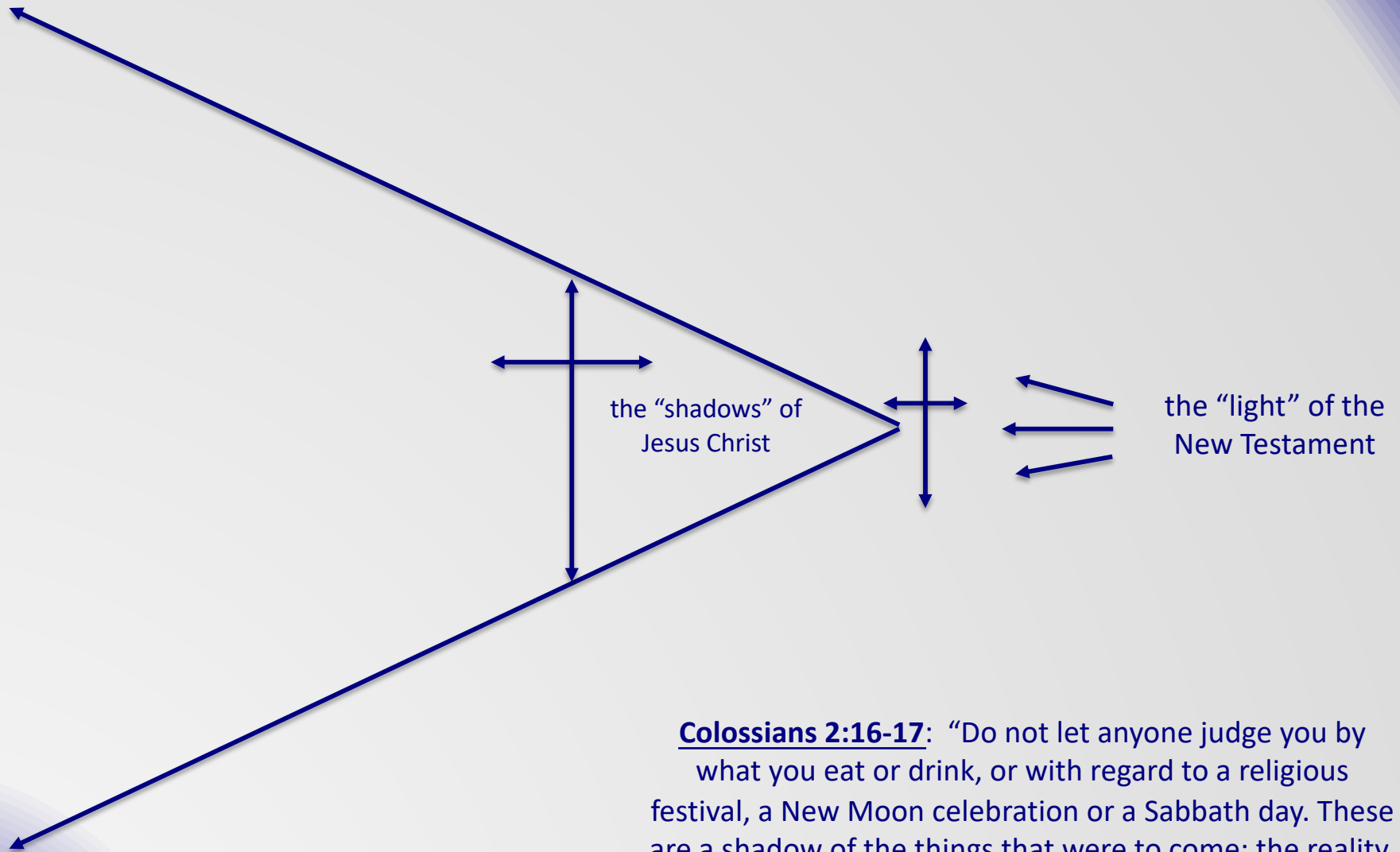
Three Foundational Questions:

How does the text speak of Jesus ...

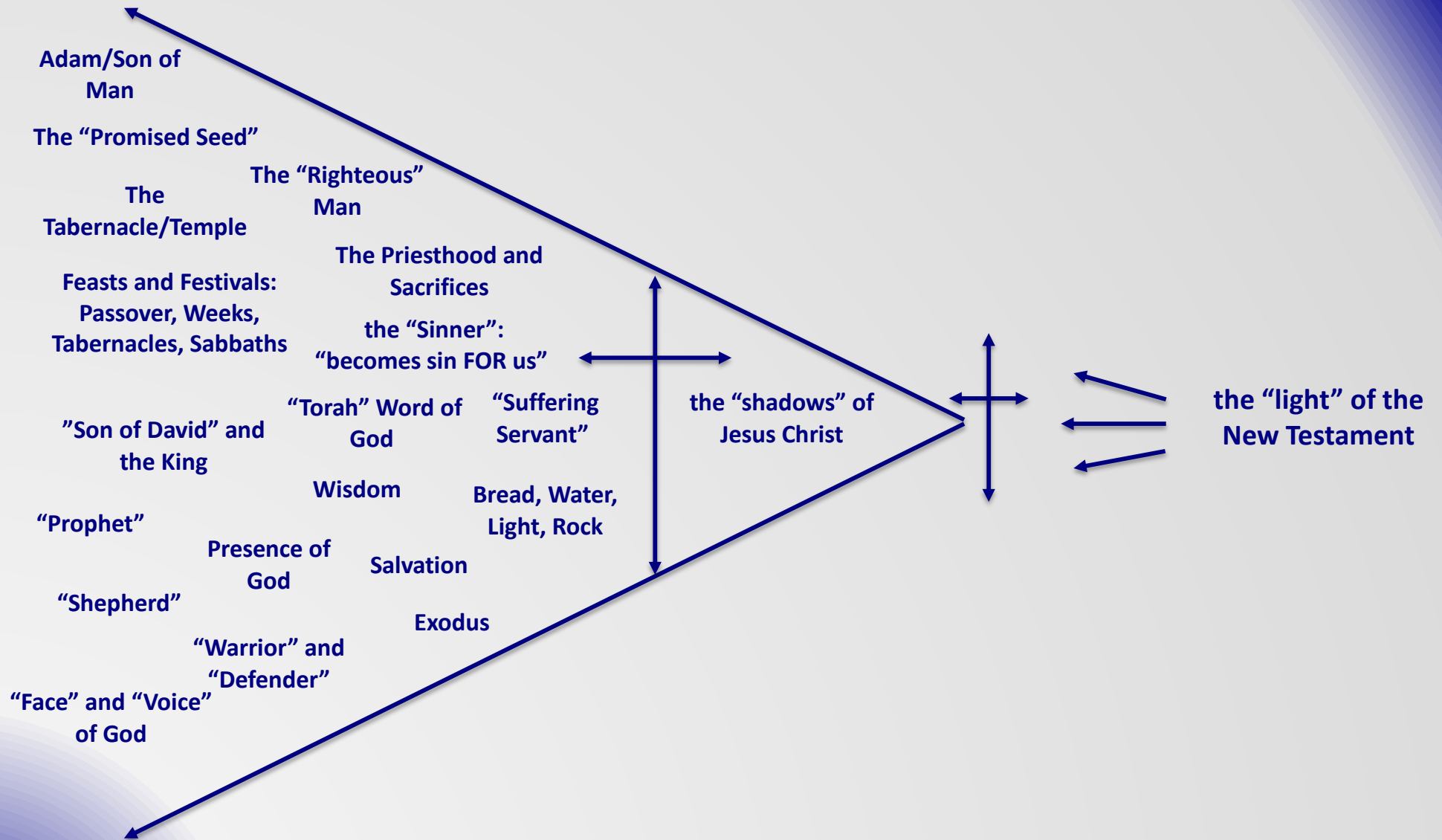
foretold in the Old Testament Scriptures?

1 Corinthians 5:7: Get rid of the old yeast that you may be a new batch without yeast--as you really are. For Christ, our Passover lamb, has been sacrificed. (NIV)

accompanied them, and that rock was Christ.
(NIV)**

John 4: Woman at the Well (living water)

John 4:10-ff: Jesus answered her, "If you knew the gift of God and who it is that asks you for a drink, you would have asked him and he would have given you living water." (NIV)

**John 4:13-ff: Jesus answered, "Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again, but whoever drinks the water I give him will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life."
(NIV)**

The Eternal Rest

Revelation 7:16-17: Never again will they hunger; never again will they thirst. The sun will not beat upon them, nor any scorching heat. (NIV)

**Revelation 7:16-17: For the Lamb at the center of the throne will be their shepherd; he will lead them to springs of living water. And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes."
(NIV)**

The Gospel of John

Jesus tabernacles with us (John 1)

living water (John 4)

the bread of life (John 6)

Deuteronomy 8:2-3: Remember how the Lord your God led you all the way in the desert these forty years, to humble you and to test you in order to know what was in your heart, whether or not you would keep his commands. (NIV)

Deuteronomy 8:2-3: He humbled you, causing you to hunger and then feeding you with manna, which neither you nor your fathers had known, to teach you that man does not live on bread alone but on every word that comes from the mouth of the Lord . (NIV)

John 6: Feeding of the 5000 (the Bread of Life)

**John 6:48-ff: I am the bread of life.
Your forefathers ate the manna in the
desert, yet they died. But here is the bread that
comes down from heaven, which a man may eat
and not die. (NIV)**

**John 6:51-ff: I am the living bread that came down from heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever. This bread is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world."
(NIV)**

Man does not live on bread alone but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.

Types of Covenants

ONE WAY – superior makes a binding covenant to another (lesser party)

“I am going to do this for you ...”

“I will keep my word ...”

“I will be faithful ...”

Types of Covenants

TWO WAY – superior makes a binding covenant to another (lesser party) AND the other party pledges a response.

with Israelites at Sinai (Mosaic)
Exodus 20 and 24:7,8

**The Triune God is the Law Giver
Jesus, our Brother, is the Law Keeper**

fulfill them = “fill them to the full”

The Gospel of Matthew
